	<p>The Chair:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Opened the meeting with an acknowledgement of country and invited any declarations of interest from participants – none were offered. Noted minutes were distributed for the previous meeting and that there were no outstanding actions.

	<p>The Chair invited the WestConnex team to provide the meeting with a project update which confirmed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No air quality complaints had been received since the last meeting

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One exceedance had been recorded at air quality monitoring stations due to dust. • Vandalism: Security concerns were discussed regarding repeated vandalism around the ventilation outlets and adjacent parkland, including damage to green wall infrastructure and local play areas. Security measures have been increased. Community representatives were unaware of the incidents prior to the meeting. • Green Wall Installation: Replacement vertical planting on the ventilation stacks remains scheduled for September, pending protection of irrigation systems from further vandalism. • Parliamentary Visit: Four MPs, including members of the NSW Committee on Transport and Infrastructure, visited the site. They observed operational systems and air quality management and gave positive feedback. • Air Quality Monitoring: Next tranche of post-opening air quality data will be collected and reviewed by December 2025. A comprehensive analysis by the Independent Air Quality Expert Dr Ian Longley will then help determine the future need for the committee to meet after it has met its formal Condition of Consent requirement to run for at least 2 years after opening of the interchange. • The Chair advised members future meetings may remain brief unless new issues emerge. Community members are encouraged to submit agenda items in advance if there are particular air quality related matters they would like to discuss.
