The community and public will be notified of these exercises, which will typically take place between 10pm and 4am.</p>	
<p>4.0 Other business</p> <p><u>Forthcoming matters for the AQCCC</u></p> <p>As discussed at the preceding meeting, the forward role of the AQCCC will relate to ongoing matters including compliance tracking reporting, audit reports and monitoring of complaints as they relate to air quality.</p> <p>The AQCCC is required to operate for at least two years subsequent to opening of the tunnel.</p> <p><u>Other business</u></p> <p>Noting that this matter is not related to air quality, community representatives sought assistance regarding the increasing graffiti appearing on the noise walls at the back of Wall Street. 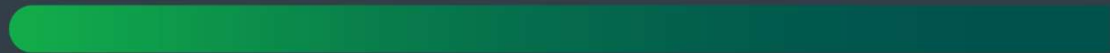

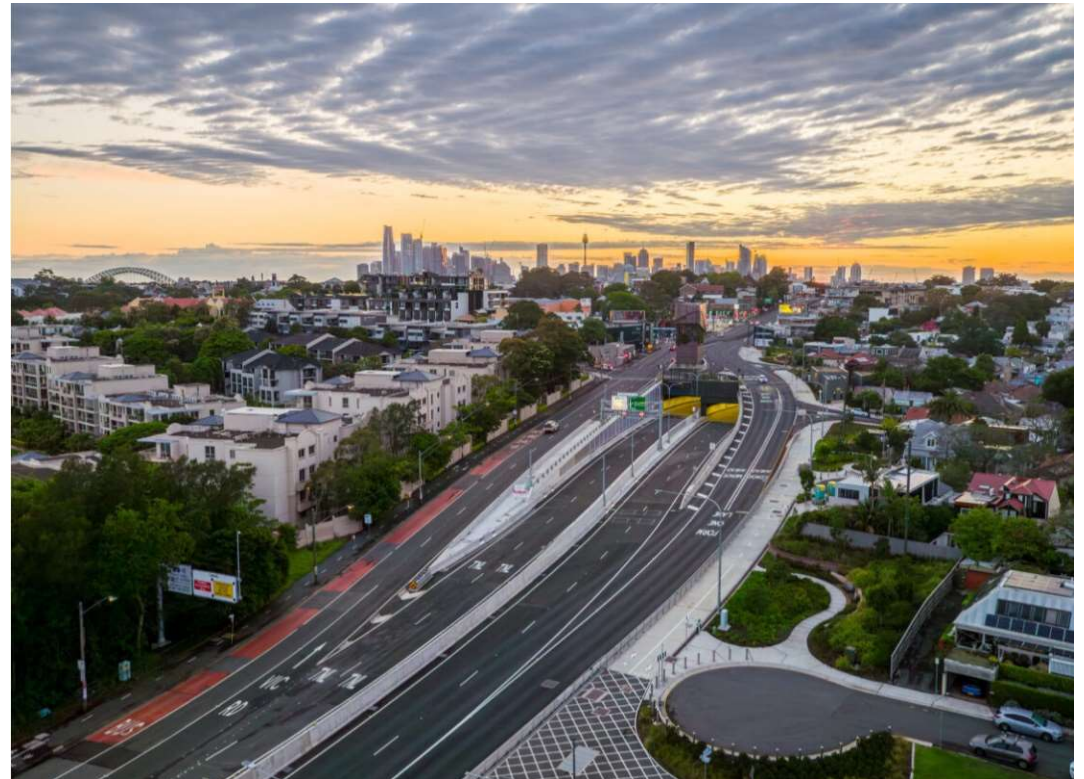
Rozelle Interchange
