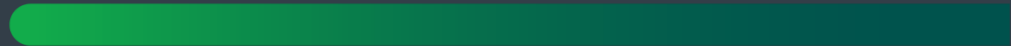
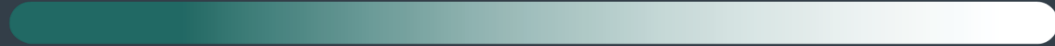

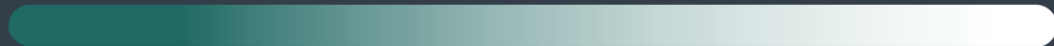

Project update



Complaints – Rozelle Interchange Air Quality

No complaints received

One Air Quality Exceedances recorded since the last AQCCC meeting.

An Ambient Above Goal reading was observed for 24hr PM₁₀ at the following Ambient Air Quality Stations

- Quirk St, 27/05/2025, value recorded at 51.1 µg/m³
- Manning St, 27/05/2025, value recorded at 54.5 µg/m³
- Chapman Rd, 27/05/2025, value recorded at 55.8 µg/m³

This was due to dust in the atmosphere.

Cause of dust haze

Jiwon Park from the Bureau of Meteorology said the dust haze is a result of "prolonged dry weather conditions and strong and gusty winds ahead of a very strong cold front".

Rozelle Interchange | MP Visit

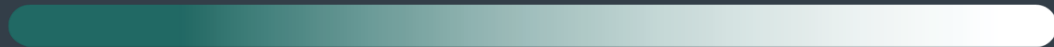
