

How to make a submission factsheet | 2017

You are invited to make a submission on the Roads and Maritime Services M4-M5 Link Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), which is currently on exhibition. WestConnex is part of the Australian and NSW governments' vision for supporting Sydney's growing population and keeping our economy strong. The M4-M5 Link is the third stage of WestConnex. It will link the New M4 Motorway at Haberfield to the New M5 Motorway at St Peters, with additional connections to the Iron Cove Bridge and Rozelle Interchange.



The M4-M5 Link includes an interchange at Rozelle providing connections to the surface road network at City West Link, Victoria Road and Anzac Bridge. It also includes a new toll-free tunnel connection between the Rozelle Interchange and Victoria Road near the Iron Cove Bridge.

What you'll find in the M4-M5 Link EIS

The EIS describes the main features of the M4-M5 Link, as well as mitigation measures for any potential environmental and social impacts that may occur during construction and operation.



Why your submission matters

The submission process is an opportunity to have your say and plays a vital role for the projects development. Roads and Maritime Services will consider all submissions received and provide a submissions report in response to the issues raised. The report is submitted to the NSW Department of Planning and Environment and helps inform the Minister for Planning's decision on the project. If the project is approved, it will be constructed and operated in accordance with the mitigation measures described in the EIS, the Submissions and Preferred Infrastructure Report, and the Minister's Conditions of Approval. The plans proposed in the EIS may evolve depending on several factors including community feedback, and the construction methodologies developed by the contractors once appointed.

If you do not wish for your details or components of your submission to be published, please state this clearly in your submission.
