



Monitoring equipment installation: Concord Street, Erskineville

The Project recently completed tunnel excavation below St Peters and Newtown. A groundwater monitoring device will now be installed below Concord Street in Erskineville.

What we're doing

From Tuesday, 29 June 2021, work to install a groundwater monitor will be carried out between 7:00am and 6:00pm Monday to Friday and 8:00am to 1:00pm on Saturdays for up to three weeks, weather permitting.

Work will be undertaken on Concord Street near Concord Lane, Erskineville.

This work will involve:

- Identifying underground services and utilities
- Setting up a safe work area with site specific environmental controls
- Traffic and pedestrian management to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers
- Setting up a drill rig mounted on the back of a truck or we may use a track mounted drill rig
- Drilling a small diameter borehole 45 metres into the ground pit
- Installing the groundwater monitor
- Covering the top of the hole with a steel cap and from time to time the project team will access the hole to measure groundwater.

Equipment required for this work includes, but is not limited to; concrete saw, jack-hammer, drilling equipment, vacuum truck, compactor, tipper truck, concrete truck, traffic control (including traffic control vehicles) and other light vehicles.

Some on street car parks will be temporarily removed to facilitate the work.

How this affects you

At times this work will be noisy. The Project is committed to minimising construction impacts on surrounding residents by:

- Consulting with directly affected residents ahead of the work taking place
