



Wattle Street footpath and driveway reinstatement

The M4-M5 Link Tunnels will permanently reinstate driveways and sections of footpath that have been impacted by recent work along the northern verge of Wattle Street in Haberfield.

What we're doing

Permanently reinstating driveways and sections of footpath along Wattle Street, Haberfield.

This is scheduled to occur across two (2) day shifts and two (2) night shifts from 10.00pm on Monday 28 June until 5.00pm on Wednesday 30 June 2021.

The work will require a temporary footpath closure along Wattle Street from Ash Lane to Parramatta Road, Haberfield. A pedestrian detour will be in place via the southern verge of Wattle Street or along Ash Lane and Wolseley Street, Haberfield. See map over the page for details.

Full access will be restored on Wattle Street by 5:00pm on Wednesday 30 June 2021.

How this affects you

There may be some noise associated with the reinstatement work.. The project is committed to mitigating construction impacts on surrounding residents by:

- scheduling high noise activities as early as possible
- consulting with directly impacted residents ahead of the work
- installing noise blankets around the work area where possible
- using non-tonal reversing beepers and instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum.

Equipment required for this work includes, but is not limited to, saw cutters, jackhammers, hand tools, compactors, excavators, tipper trucks, concrete trucks, vacuum excavators, lighting towers, traffic control (inclusive of traffic control vehicles) and light vehicles.

Traffic and pedestrian changes

Temporary single lane closures on Wattle Street between Parramatta Road and Ramsay Street, Haberfield will be required for some activities. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists.

The footpath along the northern verge of Wattle Street will be temporarily closed from Ash Lane to Parramatta Road with a detour in place, via the southern verge of Wattle Street or via along Ash Lane and Wolseley Street Haberfield.

Work will be undertaken across driveways with impacted residents consulted to ensure appropriate access requirements are in place.
