Night work to reconfigure median strip and install new traffic light pole

As part of the M4-M5 Link Tunnels project, an existing median strip and traffic light located on Kent Road, Mascot at the intersection with Gardeners Road, needs to be reconfigured and replaced to assist road users to safely and efficiently navigate the road network once the M4-M5 Link Tunnels become operational.

What we're doing

Due to the proximity of the median strip to the road, the work will be required to be undertaken at night to ensure the safety of workers and motorists. To provide respite for nearby residents, work will occur for a maximum of two nights in a row, no more than three nights per week and no more than 10 nights per calendar month in total.

The work has been scheduled to occur across two weeks and will begin Tuesday 7 December to Wednesday 8 December and Monday 13 December to Tuesday 14 December, with contingency on Wednesday 15 December 2021.

Work will occur between 9:00pm - 5:00am Monday to Sunday. All high impact activities have been scheduled to cease at midnight each night to minimise impact on the community.

The work will involve:

- setting up a safe work area with site specific environmental controls
- traffic and pedestrian management to ensure the safety or motorists, residents and workers
- removing the existing median strip and kerb and installing a new reconfigured median strip and kerb
- removing the existing traffic pole and installing a new traffic pole with directional signage
- restoring the asphalt around the work area
- restoring the line markings on the road.

Equipment required for this work includes, but is not limited to; road saws, excavators, mobile cranes, elevated working platforms, traffic control, tipper trucks, concrete trucks, delivery vehicles, light vehicles, concrete agitators, compactors, hammers, lighting towers, and hand tools.

How this affects you

This work is expected to have some noise impacts on nearby residents and the Project is committed to minimising construction noise to surrounding residents and businesses by using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use, directing noisy equipment away from residences, where possible and installing noise blankets around temporary work areas. All high impact activities have been scheduled to cease at midnight in order to provide respite to directly impacted residents.

During the work, temporary parking, traffic and pedestrian changes will be required, including traffic control and directional signage.
