Upcoming night work for sign installation on Wattle Street, Haberfield

The M4-M5 Link Tunnels project team will install three (3) new signs, three (3) overheight sensors and one (1) set of traffic lights in Haberfield along Wattle Street. The new signs are required to assist road users to safely and efficiently navigate the road network once the M4-M5 Link Tunnels become operational.

What we're doing

Work to install the various signs in Haberfield will be carried out from Wednesday 1 December and will take approximately six (6) night shifts to complete. The signs will be installed onto the previously installed concrete footings in various locations along Wattle Street in Haberfield. Exact locations are provided on the map over the page.

Due to the high volume of traffic during the day, work along Wattle Street must be scheduled outside of standard construction hours to ensure the safety of pedestrians, motorists and workers.

The work will be carried out between 9:00pm - 5:00am Monday to Sunday. To provide respite for nearby residents, noisy work will occur for a maximum of two nights in a row, no more than three nights per week and no more than ten nights per calendar month.

Additional specific notification will be provided to impacted residents as work progresses.

This work will involve:

- closing lanes on Wattle Street between Parramatta Road and Ramsay Street, Haberfield
- setting up a safe work area with site specific environmental controls
- setting up traffic management to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians, residents and workers
- attaching sign posts to the foundations
- attaching the sign faces to the posts.

Equipment required for this work includes, but is not limited to; trucks, traffic control (including traffic control vehicles) and other light vehicles, mobile cranes (franna), elevated work platforms and hand tools.

How this affects you

This work will at times be noisy. The Project is committed to mitigating construction impacts on surrounding residents by:

- scheduling noisier activities such as saw-cutting as early as possible
- consulting with directly impacted residents ahead of the work taking place
- using noise blankets and other barriers to reduce noise impacts where possible
- directing temporary lighting away from properties
- using non-tonal reversing beepers and instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum.

Traffic changes

Temporary changes to traffic routes around the work site will be required. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists through these changes.
