Iron Cove work update | Week starting 12 April 7 Apr 2021

Iron Cove community survey

Updated night work

Due to wet weather conditions expected later this evening, work scheduled to take place on Victoria Road tonight Wednesday 7 April has been re-scheduled to take place tomorrow night Thursday 8 April.

Next week, night work is scheduled for Monday 12, Tuesday 13 and Thursday 15 April between 7pm and 6am.

Night work will take place on Victoria Road between Springside and Byrnes streets, and involves installing storm water drainage on Victoria Road using a rock hammer.

Whilst not planned, work may continue past midnight if the crew aren't able to complete excavation on Victoria Road as it will impact the ability to reopen traffic lanes and provide safe driving conditions for motorists. Every effort will be made to avoid this, with some of the excavation occurring during the daytime to reduce the amount of work at night. We'll also continue to implement noise mitigation measures such as noise blankets and turning off machinery when not in use. We apologise in advance, for any disruption this work may have.

Please note, night work will continue to take place up to 3 nights per week at Iron Cove over the coming weeks as we prepare to open the new westbound lanes.

Tunnelling update

The roadheader is currently excavating the ventilation tunnel under Springside Street and progressing towards Moodie streets.

From Monday 12 April until Monday 03 May, the roadheader will be excavating the orange section beneath Springside Street towards Moodie Street. Roadheader excavation will continue to be undertaken mainly between 6am Monday to 6am Saturday (24 hours per day). However, next week we'll have a change to our hours of operation and we'll be excavating at 6pm Sunday 18 April.



Toelle Street - trenching for permanent power

As you may have noticed, trenching has started on Toelle Street. Trenching will take approximately eight weeks to complete, weather and site conditions permitting.



Toelle Street - upcoming power outage

As you may be aware, Ausgrid has scheduled a power outage for Thursday 15 April from 7am to 5pm.

While the Project requires outages to safely perform work, the time, date and duration of the outage is determined by Ausgrid and reliant on their network and staffing availability.

We'll be working hard to get the power on early if possible. We sincerely apologise in advance, for any inconvenience or disruption caused by the outage, and ask residents with extenuating circumstances to get in touch at info@rozelleinterchange.com.au.

Please note: if you have not received an interruption notice from Ausgrid then your household is not affected by the outage on Thursday 15 April.

We also recommend you take some basic precautions before and during the interruption:


- Ensure mobile devices are fully charged
- Unplug or switch off appliances or sensitive electronic equipment including water pumps and three phase motors associated with air conditioning units and lifts
- Make sure that any alarms operate correctly without mains power
- Avoid opening fridges or freezers during the interruption
- You do not need to switch off or adjust any solar installation
