Below is a summary of Rozelle Interchange construction work taking place at Iron Cove next week.

Residents impacted by our work on local streets will be provided a more detailed update in the coming days. The update has been broken into the following sections:

Night work

Night work will be carried out along Victoria Road on **Sunday 20 September**, and **Tuesday 22 September** between the hours of **7pm and 6am**, weather permitting. Work will include:

- mobilising/demobilising traffic control setup each night
- **Ausgrid work** (more on this overleaf).

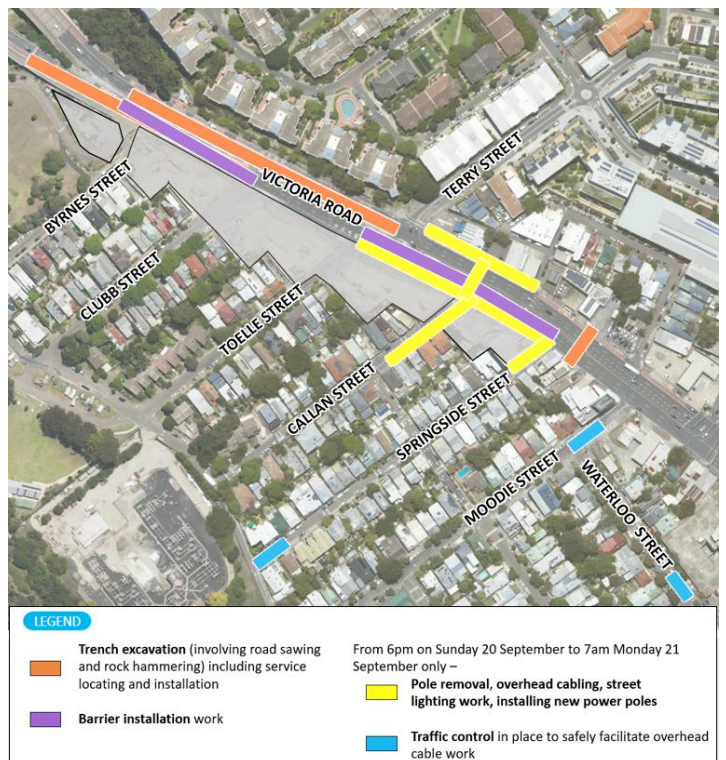
Traffic control will also be in place during this time to facilitate overhead cable work

- **trench excavation** on Victoria Road to install new stormwater and electrical conduits:

- Clubb Street to the Iron Cove Bridge (2nd week of 5 weeks work)
- Byrnes Street to Callan Street (11th week of 18 weeks work)
- Springside Street to Moodie Street (last week of work)

- **barrier installation** Victoria Road between Clubb and Byrnes streets, and between Toelle and Springside streets (2nd week of 2 week work)
- backfilling and reinstatement of the trenching area each night

Trench excavation, road sawing and rock hammering are loud activities, and may be required on each of these nights. As a result, night work next week is expected to generate high levels of noise.



Ausgrid work and power outage

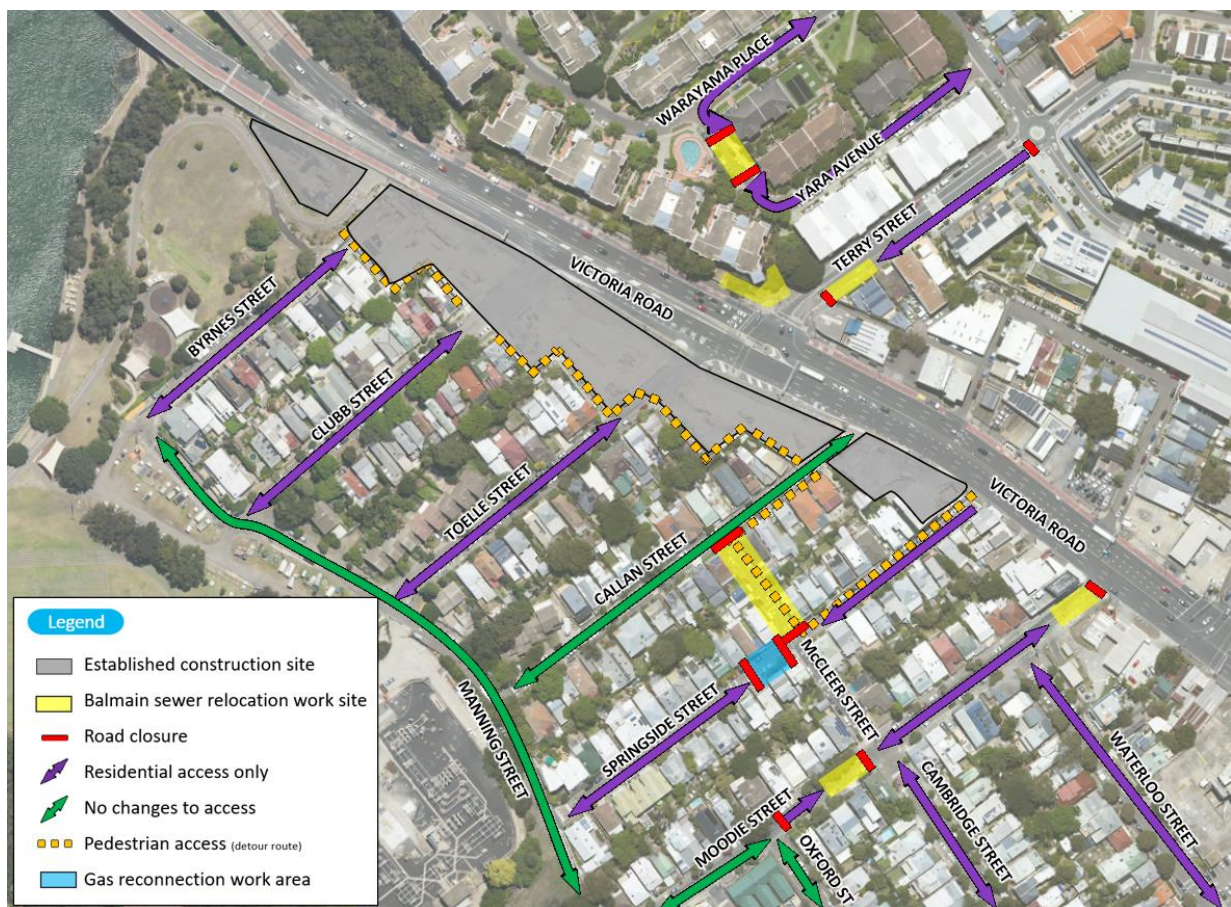
We'll be relocating, installing and upgrading new Ausgrid electrical services from 6pm Sunday 20 September to 7am Monday 21 September.

This work will result in a temporary outage affecting properties between 7pm and 5am. **Ausgrid have notified the properties who are expected to be impacted by this outage.**

Traffic changes on local streets

- Next week we'll continue trenching on McCleer Street between Callan and Springside streets to construct private sewer connections as part of the Balmain sewer relocation.
- We'll be undertaking gas reconnection work on Springside Street next week. Residents affected by this work will be notified this week.
- We'll also continue trenching for the new sewer line on Yara Avenue. This work requires Yara Avenue to be closed to non-residents. Resident access to all buildings will be maintained (please display your Resident Access Card for efficient access to Yara Avenue).



Tunnelling update

Tunnelling activities are currently scheduled to start in Iron Cove in mid-October 2020 and will take approximately one year to complete.

These images show roadheader tunnelling machines inside the new tunnels being excavated near the Rozelle Railyards. The majority of the Rozelle Interchange tunnels are excavated using a roadheader, which is a special excavation machine that cuts the rock in a circular motion.
