

### Utility investigation work in Haberfield

As part of the Rozelle Interchange project, some existing utilities need to be identified and relocated as they fall within the construction footprint. One of these utilities is a redundant Ausgrid power cable that runs from Reg Coady Reserve to Rozelle.

We're almost complete utility investigation work within the Reg Coady Reserve, Haberfield. Please find updated information about this work below.

We sincerely thank you for your patience while we carried out this important work.

### What we're doing

Now that we've determined the exact location of the cable, we need to reopen the section of the ground at the Reg Coady Reserve, cut and remove the redundant cable. This work will be carried out during the day from **Monday 14 September** and is expected to take **up to one week to complete**.

The work will involve:

- Setting up a temporary work area including traffic control, fencing and delivery of equipment
- Opening a small section of the ground and removing the dirt to reveal the location of the power cable
- Cutting and pulling the cables to remove them
- Backfilling the ground and reinstating the work area

### What to expect

A vacuum truck and small excavator will be used to excavate the ground and to remove the dirt. These machines will create intermittent periods of high noise.

From Monday 14 to Saturday 20 September

### Hours of operation

Work will occur during standard construction hours between 7am and 6pm each day.

### Where

At the intersection of Reg Coady Reserve and Wattle Street, Haberfield
