Local road resurfacing

We'd like to thank you for your ongoing support and cooperation while we continue asphaltting work to resurface a number of local streets.

Asphaltting is continuing today, Wednesday 7 and tomorrow, Thursday 8 July on the streets mentioned below. This work is highly weather dependant.

In order to carry out this work we'll need residents to remove their cars from local streets on designated days. Unfortunately, if cars are not removed on the particular dates, asphaltting work cannot proceed.

A number of road closures will also be in place during the work.

The table below lists the streets impacted by asphaltting taking place today and tomorrow Thursday 8 July.

Tunnelling update

We'd like to thank you for your continued patience as we understand residents living close to the tunnels are experiencing ongoing noise and vibration.

From Monday 12 July, the roadheader will start to excavate the orange section beneath properties on Cambridge and Waterloo streets. We expect to be excavating the orange section until Monday 2 August.

Due to the tunnels width, the roof of the orange sections are being excavated in halves, a tunnelling technique called 'lead and trail'. This means we'll excavate half

of the tunnel before we return to excavate the other half. As a result, the roadheader may pass under or near a property twice to excavate.

Over the next three weeks we'll remove the floor of the tunnel under Cambridge and Waterloo streets shown inside the red dash sections in the image below. This work is known as benching and involves using a roadheader to excavate the bottom portion of the tunnel. Noise and vibration impacts from benching will be similar to what you experienced during recent excavation of the tunnel roof but for a shorter duration.

We've had an update to our sequencing of tunnel excavation under Moodie, Cambridge and Waterloo streets. To view the next eight-week sequencing map please click [here](#). Roadheader excavation will continue to be undertaken mainly between 6am Monday to 6am Saturday (24 hours per day).



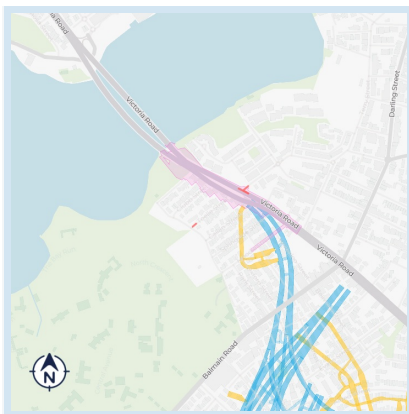
Footpath restoration work
