Iron Cove weekly work update

Week starting Monday 14 December (No.227)

Good afternoon

Below is a summary of Rozelle Interchange construction work taking place at Iron Cove next week. Residents impacted by our work on local streets will be provided a more detailed update in the coming days. This update has been broken into the following sections:

- holiday shutdown & free ice cream at the park
- power outage this Saturday
- next week's night work
- tunnelling update
- traffic changes next week



The project will cease work at Iron Cove (including tunnelling) for the holiday season from Friday 18 December 2020 and recommence work on Monday 4 January 2021.

While some low impact activities such as security checks or minor maintenance checks may still happen during this period, we hope this break provides residents with much needed respite from the work.

We'd also like to sincerely thank the community at Iron Cove for all your patience, kindness and tolerance towards our project team and crews throughout this challenging and very unprecedented year.

On **Tuesday 15 December** we'll be hosting a complimentary ice cream afternoon at King George Park to say thank you. The ice cream truck will be available from **4pm to 6.30pm** and we really hope to see you there. Don't forget your kids and pets!

Night work

Reminder: night work tonight and tomorrow will be noisy as we're re-asphalting the road between Springside and Callan streets. As advised, to safely facilitate this work, a road closure will be in place on Callan Street between Victoria Road and McCleer Street from 8pm tonight and tomorrow night.

Night work will be carried out on Victoria Road on Monday 14, Tuesday 15 and Thursday 17 December between the hours of 7pm and 6am, weather permitting. We'll let you know if a contingency night is required due to weather or unexpected site conditions throughout the week.

Night work next week will include:

- mobilising/demobilising traffic control setup each night
- potholing and trench excavation involving road sawing and rock hammering (expected completion early January)
- Sydney trains cable installation involving winching equipment
- traffic control setup
- established work sites

Trench excavation is a loud construction activity involving road sawing and rock hammering. As a result, night work next week is unfortunately expected to continue to create high levels of noise.

Equipment used for night work includes but isn't limited to: asphalting removal machines, road saws, vacuum trucks, excavators with hammers, compaction machines, winching equipment, concrete agis, hand tools and construction vehicles.

Reason for night work: While the Project prefers to carry out work during the daytime when shifts are longer and workers are readily available we're unable to do so when working on busy roads such as Victoria Road. We must carry out work at night when traffic volumes on these roads are lower and we can maintain safety of workers and the surrounding community.



_Preparation work for the cable installation will be carried out on Wednesday night (16 Dec) on Moodie Street and Victoria Road. We do not expect this work to be noisy however you may notice workers in the above locations.

Power outage this Saturday



A power outage is scheduled for this **Saturday 12 December** from **6am to 5pm** to safely facilitate utility work on Victoria Road. All affected properties have been notified by Ausgrid. Further information about the work and traffic changes is attached to this email and on the Live Traffic website.

Traffic impacts may be significant from this work:



- Traffic lanes will be reduced on Victoria Road in both directions this **Saturday 12 December** from 5am until work is complete on Victoria Road.
- Traffic control will be in place on Victoria Road to safely assist motorists, cyclists and pedestrians around the work areas.
- Crystal Street will be residential access only from Friday to Saturday evening.

Please allow for extra time travelling to and from Victoria Road in both directions this Saturday.


Tunnelling update

Day time tunnelling (7am to 6pm) is progressing within our work site adjacent to Callan Street with 40 metres excavated. Next week's expected tunnelling location is shown in light green in the side map.

We expect to start day and night-time tunnelling in early 2021 and will let you know as soon as a start date can be confirmed.

Footpath reopening (between Springside & Callan)

We're pleased to advise that we'll be opening the new pathway between Springside and Callan streets earlier than expected and ahead of schedule. The pathway in this location will be available from next **Friday 18 December**.

Please note: we are currently finalising reinstatement work at the Yara Avenue work area and will be packing down our temporary work site for the holiday shutdown from this **Friday 11 December**. The temporary work site will be restablished on **Monday 4 January 2021**.

Daytime work areas and traffic changes on local streets



Work is happening in two locations from Monday 14 to Friday 18 December between 7am and 6pm:

- Manning Street at the Moodie Street intersection: trenching and drilling for the Sydney Trains Pilot Cable.
- McCleer Street between Springside and Callan streets: trenching for the new sewer connection
- Parking is required around all work areas for trenching work

The below map shows the different work areas next week:

- New day work areas next week requiring parking removal, intermittent road closures and traffic control
- Established work sites with work ongoing
- Traffic access and residential only during work periods
- road closure during work periods from 7am to 6pm
- Stop/slow on Callan Street at Victoria Road in place during work periods (7am to 6pm, Mon to Sat)
