# Monitoring equipment installation: Darley Street, Newtown

The Project recently completed tunnel excavation below St Peters and Newtown. A groundwater monitoring device will now be installed below Darley Street in Newtown.

#### What we're doing

From Wednesday, 14 July 2021, work to install a groundwater monitor will be carried out between 7:00am and 6:00pm Monday to Friday and 8:00am to 1:00pm on Saturdays for up to two weeks, weather permitting.

Work will be undertaken on Darley Street near King Street, Newtown.

This work will involve:

- Identifying underground services and utilities
- Setting up a safe work area with site specific environmental controls
- Traffic and pedestrian management to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers
- Setting up a drill rig mounted on the back of a truck or we may use a track mounted drill rig
- Drilling a small diameter borehole 60 metres into the ground pit
- Installing the groundwater monitor
- Covering the top of the hole with a steel cap and from time to time the project team will access the hole to measure groundwater.

Equipment required for this work includes, but is not limited to; concrete saw, jackhammer, drilling equipment, vacuum truck, compactor, tipper truck, concrete truck, traffic control (including traffic control vehicles) and other light vehicles.

#### How this affects you

At times this work will be noisy. The Project is committed to minimising construction impacts on surrounding residents by:

- Consulting with directly affected residents ahead of the work taking place
- Using noise blankets and other barriers to reduce noise where possible.
