Work notification | 10 May 2021

Night work to install an Anti-throw Safety Screen between Martin Street and Ramsay Street, Haberfield

From Monday, 24 May 2021, work will be undertaken to install an Anti-throw Safety Screen along the M4 Westbound on-ramp between Martin Street and Ramsay Street, Haberfield. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

What we're doing

Due to the high volume of traffic during the day, work along the M4 Westbound on-ramp will be scheduled outside of standard construction hours to ensure the safety of pedestrians, motorists and workers. An Anti-throw Safety Screen will be installed along the M4 Westbound on-ramp, between Martin Street and Ramsay Street, Haberfield. This work has been scheduled to take place between Monday, 24 May and Thursday, 3 June 2021 (with no work occurring on 28 and 29 May) between the hours of 9:00pm to 5:00am Sunday to Thursday. The work is expected to take approximately two weeks to complete, weather and site conditions permitting.

The work will involve:

- Vertical lifting and handling of fabricated panel systems by use of cranes and Elevated Work Platforms (EWP's)
- Fixing and grouting of posts into the existing concrete barrier
- Establishment of temporary work zones on the M4 Westbound on-ramp
- Establishment of work zones on the existing grassed area adjacent to the shared pathway, as well as the area between Martin Street and Ramsay Street, Haberfield.

Equipment required for this work includes, but is not limited to; a crane, rattle gun, light vehicles and EWP's.

There will be some noise associated with this work, however every effort will be made to minimise the impact of work, including:

Traffic changes

Temporary changes to traffic routes will be required along the M4 Westbound on-ramp while the work is taking place. This work requires a temporary single lane closure of the M4 Westbound on-ramp. Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians, residents and workers through these changes.
