## Short term change to standard construction hours

## Work on Sundays to maintain social distancing

We're writing to let you know about some changes to our standard work hours for the next few weeks.

In response to the rapidly changing situation regarding the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) pandemic and in line with health advice released by the NSW Government, the Rozelle Interchange Project will be carrying out some construction activities between **8am and 6pm on Sundays during July and August**. Additional working hours on Sundays has been approved by the NSW Government to further encourage social distancing between workers on construction sites.

This notification outlines the work we will be doing and why this is required to be done on Sundays. Further information about this work will be included in our weekly email updates.

## Why is this change necessary?

The health and safety of the community, our stakeholders and our workers is our number one priority and we want to ensure that we are doing all that we can to minimise the risk of transmission and unnecessary exposure to COVID-19.

Some of our current activities need to be carried out in confined work areas. We are currently installing new stormwater drainage on The Crescent near underground Sydney Trains cables. This work needs to be done under special supervision of Sydney Trains personnel and requires a power outage on the cables while we are working. This outage does not affect any train services, however there are limitations on the times we are able to do this work.

Work at other locations as shown on the map over the page, will also be carried out on Sundays due to the number of teams identified as currently working in the same area. Working on a Sunday allows us to reduce the number of people working in proximity at the same time because we can spread the work over more days. By doing this, we can ensure appropriate social distancing protocols are followed.

## About the work

Work on Sundays is expected to take place in three locations on The Crescent and Victoria Road, as indicated in the maps overleaf. Our activities in these locations may include:

- installing new stormwater drainage
- building retaining walls
- tie-in work at Victoria Road for the new shared user path connecting to the ANZAC Bridge.

A temporary work site and traffic control will be in place when we are working. We may not work in all three locations at the same time and this work is not expected to generate high impact noise. Equipment used for this work may include vacuum trucks, excavators, loader cranes, road compactors and hand tools.

We'll make every effort to minimise noise associated with this work by turning off equipment when not in use and installing temporary noise blankets around our temporary work sites.
