

Utility investigation work in Haberfield

As part of the Rozelle Interchange project, some existing utilities need to be identified and relocated as they fall within the construction footprint. One of these utilities is a redundant Ausgrid power cable that runs from Reg Coady Reserve to Rozelle.

Most of this work will be carried out during the day however due to the location of work being on a busy intersection, some work may be required at night for the safety of our workers, motorists, pedestrians and cyclists around our work areas.

What we're doing

In order to determine the exact location of the cable, we need to open the ground at various locations at the intersection of Reg Coady Reserve and Wattle Street. This work is known as service investigations or potholing. Investigation work will start at this location from **Wednesday 26 August** and is expected to take **up to four weeks to complete**.

The work will involve:

- Setting up a temporary work area including traffic control, fencing, and delivery of equipment
- Excavating a small section of ground, and removing the dirt to reveal the location of the power cable
- Backfilling the ground and reinstating the work area

The team may be required to complete this activity multiple times and move in between these locations depending on where the cable is located. Impacted residents and businesses will be updated as the work progresses.

Work will occur between 7am to 6pm during the daytime and 7pm to 6am at night.

What to expect

A vacuum truck and small excavator will be used to excavate the ground and to remove the dirt. These machines will create intermittent periods of high noise.

Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists safely around the work area. There may be temporary detours in place during the work, so we encourage you to watch out for signage and our traffic control personnel.

We'll make every effort to minimise the impacts associated with this work by:

- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Installing noise blankets around the temporary work site where possible
- Having traffic control in place to guide motorists, pedestrians and cyclists around the work area
