



Air quality monitoring station installation work - Wattle Street, Haberfield

The M4-M5 Link Tunnels will construct an ambient air quality monitoring station on Wattle Street near Ramsay Street, Haberfield.

What we're doing

This work is scheduled to occur over two (2) weeks including two (2) night shifts from Monday, 19 July 2021.

Night work is scheduled for Monday 19 July and Friday 23 July between 9.00pm and 6.00am.

A concrete footing will be constructed on the southern verge of Wattle Street, approximately 50 metres west of Ramsay Street, Haberfield. A fence will be installed around the footing and an ambient air quality monitoring station will be installed on the footing at a later date.

The station will monitor air quality and will remain in place for at least three (3) years. The monitoring results will be recorded and published online and be accessible via the WestConnex website.

How this affects you

There may be some noise associated with the excavation work for the concrete footing. The project is committed to minimising construction impacts on surrounding residents by:

- scheduling high noise activities as early as possible
- consulting with directly impacted residents ahead of the work
- installing noise blankets around the work area where possible
- using non-tonal reversing beepers and instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- directing noisy equipment away from residences where possible.

No vegetation will be removed as part of this work.
