

Updated information about night time road closures next week | Rozelle, Lilyfield and Annandale (week starting 26 April)

Good afternoon everyone

We're writing to let you know that the road closures planned to facilitate night work on Tuesday night next week (27 April) have changed.

The eastbound approach lanes to the Anzac Bridge will now remain open during our work on Tuesday night and motorists are no longer required to use alternative routes to access the city.

Reduced lanes and changed traffic conditions will still be in place around our work areas between 9pm Tuesday night and 5am Wednesday morning, including on City West Link, The Crescent, Johnston Street and the Victoria Road Access Road.

The night work notification below has also been updated to reflect this change. We apologise for any inconvenience this change may cause.
