## WestConnex is carrying out geotechnical investigations throughout the M4-M5 Link project corridor.

These investigations involve the collection of soil and rock samples using a small drilling rig.

The samples are analysed to help us understand the ground conditions in the area, including the water table, and help inform the project design, method of construction and the Environmental Impact Statement.

Generally, work takes place between 7.00am to 6.00pm Monday and Friday and between 8.00am and 1.00pm on Saturday and takes up to four weeks to complete.

After the investigations are finished, the sites are restored to their original condition.

Geotechnical investigations are a normal part of planning and are undertaken in accordance with the *Roads Act, 1993*.
