

We're installing an air quality monitor at Rozelle to prepare for the proposed M4-M5 Link.

Work is continuing to improve connectivity and reduce congestion across Sydney. This work is part of a broad transport plan for the city which includes light rail, improved public transport reliability and better, more reliable motorway solutions.

Recently, planning commenced for the M4-M5 Link – the final stage of the WestConnex project linking the M4 at Haberfield to the M5 at St Peters.

As part of the planning process, an air quality assessment will be undertaken to better understand air quality conditions in the local area. To complete this assessment, an air quality monitor will soon be installed adjacent to the City West Link near Rozelle Goods Yard.

The monitor will operate 24 hours a day over the next 12 months, and the information collected will be used to prepare air quality studies for the proposed M4-M5 Link.

Work to install the monitor will start from 14 March 2016 and take about two weeks to complete. To reduce the impact on local residents this work will be carried out between 7am and 6pm from Monday to Friday, weather permitting. No work will take place on Saturday, Sunday or public holidays.

Throughout March, the project team will also be carrying out survey work in the Rozelle Goods Yard and near Victoria Road. This survey work is non-intrusive and will only occur during the day.

Frequently asked questions

What will the air quality monitoring station measure?

The monitoring station will measure oxides of nitrogen (NOx, NO and NO₂), carbon monoxide (CO), ozone (O₃), particulate matter (PM₁₀ and PM_{2.5}), hydrocarbons (total, methane and non-methane).

Will there be a ventilation outlet at Rozelle in the future?

M4-M5 Link is in the early stages of planning and no decisions have been made on the location of the project's air intakes and outlets.

What about the Office of Environment and Heritage (OEH) monitoring stations?

The data from the M4-M5 Link air quality monitors will complement the data from the existing OEH monitoring network. This network provides the community with accurate and up-to-date information about air quality and is available online at www.environment.nsw.gov.au/AQMS/search.htm

What will the monitoring stations look like?

The air quality monitor will be approximately 3 metres long by 5 metres wide and set on a concrete base. A small equipment shelter will also be constructed and a 2.5 metre high safety fence will be built around the site.
