Upcoming night work – Canal Road, St Peters

Night work will be carried out on Canal Road to install concrete barriers and investigate underground utility services.

Work will commence on **Monday 29 May** and is expected to take up to **one week** to complete, weather permitting. Working hours are between **7pm and 5am from Monday to Saturday**. No work will be carried out on Sundays or public holidays.

This work is being carried out at night to minimise impacts to traffic during the day and to ensure the safety of road users and our workers. A map showing the location is provided overleaf.

Work activities

Work to be carried out at night will include:

- Installing concrete barriers along the site boundary next to Canal Road
- Potholing to confirm the location of underground utility services
- Sewer investigations within the cut and cover site on the corner of Canal Road and the Princes Highway.

Equipment will include trucks, light vehicles, cranes, vacuum trucks, lighting towers, hand tools and traffic management.

Minimising community impact

There may be some impacts to residents during this work, including noise. We will make every effort to minimise these impacts by:

- Turning vehicles and machinery off when not in use and using less noisy equipment
- Directing noise-generating equipment and lights away from properties where possible
- Working no more than four nights in a week, with no more than three nights in a row
- Completing the noisiest activities in the earlier part of the night.

Temporary traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Changed traffic conditions on Canal Road southbound will include reduced speed limits and a temporary closure of the kerbside southbound lane. Two-way traffic will be maintained on Canal Road during the work.

If you are travelling through the area please allow extra time for your journey and follow the signs and directions from traffic controllers. For the latest traffic information, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW app.

The footpath on Canal Road next to the site boundary will continue to be closed until late this year. A pedestrian detour is in place via the existing footpath on the other side of the road.
