



Night work to remove awning and relocate westbound bus stop on Parramatta Road, Ashfield

Work is underway to establish the Parramatta Road East and West sites. Part of this work involves removing the awnings from the Parramatta Road West civil site, disconnecting services and relocating the westbound bus stop to ensure safety of pedestrians during this work.

Two additional bus stops will be installed during this work. One on the corner of Parramatta Road and Alt Street, Ashfield, during demolition work and once complete the bus stop will be relocated back to its original stop on the corner of Bland Street. The second bus stop will be installed permanently on the corner of Chandos Street and Parramatta Road, Ashfield. A map showing the new bus stop locations and work area is provided overleaf.

What we're doing:

Due to the high volume of traffic during the daytime, this work must be conducted at night for the safety of pedestrians, motorists and workers. Work will be carried out between **10.00pm - 5.00am Monday 18 March and Tuesday 19 March 2019**. The work is expected to take two nights to complete, weather and site conditions permitting.

During this work, the project team will remove the awnings from the Parramatta Road West civil site buildings, relocate the westbound bus stop 150 metres west and install a new bus stop near Chandos Street.

Work to relocate the westbound bus stop will include:

- Setting up a safe work area with site specific environmental controls
- Traffic and pedestrian management to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers
- Removing the existing bus stop
- Installing new bus stops including signage on the corner of Parramatta Road and Alt Street, Ashfield and one on the corner of Chandos Street and Parramatta Road, Ashfield

Other works that will be undertaken at the same time includes:

- Utility investigations, disconnections, protections and relocations
- Installing temporary site scaffolding
- Closing one westbound lane on Parramatta Road. One lane will remain open to traffic
- Removing awning around the Parramatta Road West civil site
- Installing traffic barriers, signage and one elevated work platform on Alt Street and Parramatta Road westbound to disconnect services

If the work cannot be completed during this time, it will be rescheduled, and you will be notified.

Equipment required for this work includes, but is not limited to; elevated work platforms, vac-trucks, hand tools, lighting towers, traffic control and light vehicles.

How this affects you

Some of these activities will be noisy. The Project is committed to mitigating construction impacts to surrounding residents by:




- Scheduling high-impact noise activities as early as possible
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers and instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum
- Directing temporary lighting away from properties
- Consultation with directly impacted residents ahead of the work taking place

Traffic changes

Temporary changes to traffic and pedestrian routes around the work sites will be required while night work is taking place. One westbound lane along Parramatta Road, Ashfield will be shut down during these works. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists through these changes.
