



Pymont Bridge Road site – trenching work

Work is underway at the Pymont Bridge Road site to prepare for tunnelling to start mid-year. Part of this work includes installing a high voltage power supply to the site to provide electricity for tunnelling activities. Trenching will take place on footpaths and in the roadway, connecting to an existing substation on Layton Street in Camperdown.

What we're doing

Work will start from Monday 06 May 2019 and will take approximately one month to complete, weather permitting. Hours of work will vary depending on the location of work. Further information will be provided to impacted residents and businesses about upcoming changes, as the work progresses.

Workers will be accessing existing electrical pits as well as trenching along a section of the high voltage route as shown in the map over the page. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

The work will involve:

- Establishing traffic control and signage as required
- Investigating the location of existing underground services
- Accessing existing electrical pits at multiple locations. This involves excavating a trench to a depth of approximately 1.5 metres and installing structural support
- Installing new power conduits and pulling cable through
- Backfilling and reinstating the ground with asphalt

Equipment needed for this activity includes, but is not limited to vacuum trucks, compactors, excavators, saw cutters, generator, hand tools, traffic control and light vehicles.

There are no planned power outages for this work.
