



## Night work and road closures on Gardeners Road and Bourke Road/ Street, Mascot

As part of the upgrade of Gardeners Road and Bourke Road/Street, night work is required to install, relocate and upgrade power, communications and gas services. Some of this work is required to be carried out at night, outside of peak traffic volume times, under traffic management for the safety of workers, motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.

### What we're doing

Night work will continue to be carried out intermittently between **Monday 3 September and Friday 14 September** from **9pm to 5am**. Work will not occur in the same location for more than one night at a time when in close proximity to residential properties in connection with this work activity.

Work is continuing to install underground power and communication lines to facilitate the future removal of overhead power lines along Gardeners Road and Bourke Road within the Project boundary. New gas mains will also be installed in some areas.

A map showing the locations of the work is provided overleaf.

The work will involve trenching with an excavator, removing ground material, identifying the services and their depth in the ground, installing new utilities and then reinstating the road and footpaths.

Equipment used during the work will include lighting towers, hand tools, vacuum truck, excavator, bucket trucks, generators, traffic management and construction vehicles.

### Traffic changes

**A full road closure on Gardeners Road and Bourke Road/Street will be in place for the duration of each night shift.** Access to driveways located on Gardeners Road will be maintained for residents and businesses at all times. Residents and businesses will be required to provide their address to traffic control to be permitted through the road closure to their property.

Traffic control, signage, detours and reduced speed limits will be in place to assist local residents and road users to navigate through the changes. Traffic control on Gardeners Road will be setup away from residential properties where possible to minimise light and noise disruption.

- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
