The Infants' Home, Ashfield	Upgrade soft fall in around the toddlers' playgrounds.

Elm St Early Learning Centre, Burwood Heights	Embedding Reconciliation Action Plans 2018-2019 through cultural awareness training for students and teachers.
St Anthony's Family Care, Croydon	Installation of solar panels to reduce carbon footprint and reinvest funds to better support the children and young people accessing the services.
Strathfield Girls Parents and Citizens Association	Installation of solar panels, which will be the cornerstone of the green initiatives at the school.
Concord Community Garden	Purchase of a new vegepod for seed raising and propagation. Materials to build worm farms and native bee hives. New gardening tools to reduce the risk of injury to members who use them.
Pratten Park Community Sports Bowling Club, Ashfield	New, safer lawn mower to maintain the green and barefoot bowls to encourage new members to the club.
Enfield Amateur Swimming Club	Update of dolphin timing system including seven stopwatches compatible with the club's system.
