



Compaction and Piling Work at St Peters Interchange

Work continues at the St Peters Interchange site to remediate the former landfill area and to construct the various features of the interchange. Part of this work involves compaction to improve the ground condition and driven piling to provide stability for the road pavement.

What we're doing

The project has been undertaking compaction work for some months at St Peters Interchange including at the landscaped mound at Canal Road, St Peters. Compaction work involves the use of a rapid impact compaction rig to compact the landfill using a 7.5 tonne hammer. The hammer is dropped from a controlled height (up to 1 metre) approximately 40 times a minute.

Compaction work will now be moving to the construction area next to Campbell Street (east) on a trial basis for two weeks from 19 March 2018. If successful, the compaction work will be ongoing over a period of 2 months.

Piling work is being undertaken in different areas within the construction site. The piling work involves driving large concrete or steel beams into the ground to approximately 40 metres below the surface and is expected to continue for the next six months.

How this affects you

You may hear a thumping noise from compaction work. Compaction work will take place Monday to Friday from 8am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm. On each day there will be a one hour respite after three hours of work.

Piling is a common technique used in urban areas. You may hear a clanging noise and you may feel vibration in your property but there is no immediate cause for concern. Piling work will take place during standard construction hours of Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm.
