

## Toll gantry installation on the M5 East corridor and the New M5

Opening to traffic in early 2020, the New M5 will duplicate the M5 East from King Georges Road Interchange at Beverly Hills, to a new interchange at St Peters. The New M5 tunnels will be marked for two lanes in each direction.

Toll gantries are being installed along the M5 corridor as part of the New M5 project. Toll gantries will be installed at:

- The King Georges Road on and off ramps and main carriageway at Beverly Hills.
- The Kingsgrove Road on and off ramps at Kingsgrove.
- The Bexley Road on and off ramps at Bexley North.
- The off ramp exit for Princes Highway Arncliffe.

- The Marsh Street on and off ramps and main carriageway at Arncliffe.

Two gantries will be built as part of the New M5 tunnels near the tunnel portals at the St Peters Interchange.

### What is a Gantry?

A gantry is a structure assembly which will contain the apparatus for traffic monitoring, camera and open road tolling systems.

### What to Expect

Installation of the gantries work will be undertaken outside of normal construction hours for the safety of workers and motorists and during the standard monthly M5 East shutdowns to minimise the impact on residents and motorists.

### Toll Testing

Tolls will not be charged until the New M5 opens in early 2020.

Toll testing is expected to start in late 2018 to ensure the accuracy of the tolling equipment. The community and motorists will be provided with advance notice and will not be charged during testing.

### What to Expect

The installation of gantries at the on and off ramps at Kingsgrove Road will be completed by early 2019.

The installation of the gantries at the on and off ramps at Kingsgrove Road will be completed by the end of 2018.

The remaining gantries will be installed by mid - 2019.

These works will be undertaken outside of normal construction hours for the safety of workers and motorists and during the standard monthly M5 East shutdowns to minimise the impact on residents and motorists.
