

Kingsgrove

Welcome to our construction update for Kingsgrove as part of the WestConnex New M5 project. Updates will be distributed monthly to keep you informed of upcoming activities in your area.

Construction is now underway across the three New M5 Kingsgrove sites, which are located north and south of the M5 East Motorway (see map overleaf).

Since July 2016, substantial progress has been made to establish these sites, including:

- installing temporary noise barriers
- installing temporary pedestrian and cycle paths
- removing parts of the earth mound near Glamis Street, Armitree Street and Rosebank Avenue
- making changes to sections of the M5 East to create a safe work area for construction workers.

Upcoming activities

Work being carried out across the Kingsgrove sites in November includes:

- ongoing removal of the earth mound and some noise walls adjacent to the motorway
- ongoing work to install underground utility services, including, stormwater and sewer systems
- constructing fencing, internal access roads, car parks, hardstand areas and access points
- progressing the removal of existing buildings and structures within the site on Garema Circuit
- commencing excavation for tunnel shafts within the sites on Commercial Road and Garema Circuit
- progressing the installation of piles north and south of the M5 East Motorway to provide a solid foundation for the bypass lanes and tunnel entry/exit portals
- further work to install temporary buildings such as site offices, storage facilities, sheds and amenities.

Plant and equipment to be used during these works includes trucks, construction vehicles, piling rigs, hand tools, lighting towers, generators, excavation and boring equipment, cranes, compactors, compressors and pumps. Every effort will be made to minimise the impact of work on nearby residents and businesses.

Community Information Session

A community information session will be held on **19 November 2016 at 30 Garema Circuit, Kingsgrove from 10am to 1pm**. This session has been organised for residents and stakeholders to meet the project team, obtain information about the project and the construction methods used, as well as provide feedback. This session will also include a presentation at 10am on the noise wall design options near Glamis Street, Armitree Street and Rosebank Avenue.

New M5 work will generally be carried out during standard construction hours **between 7am and 6pm from Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturday**. There will be no work on Sundays and public holidays unless notified otherwise. Some activities may be undertaken outside of standard construction hours including monitoring by security personnel and workers accessing construction sites.


In November, there will be night works on the motorway side during the standard M5 East shutdown period. This is required for the safety of workers and motorists. Nearby residents will be notified in advance.
