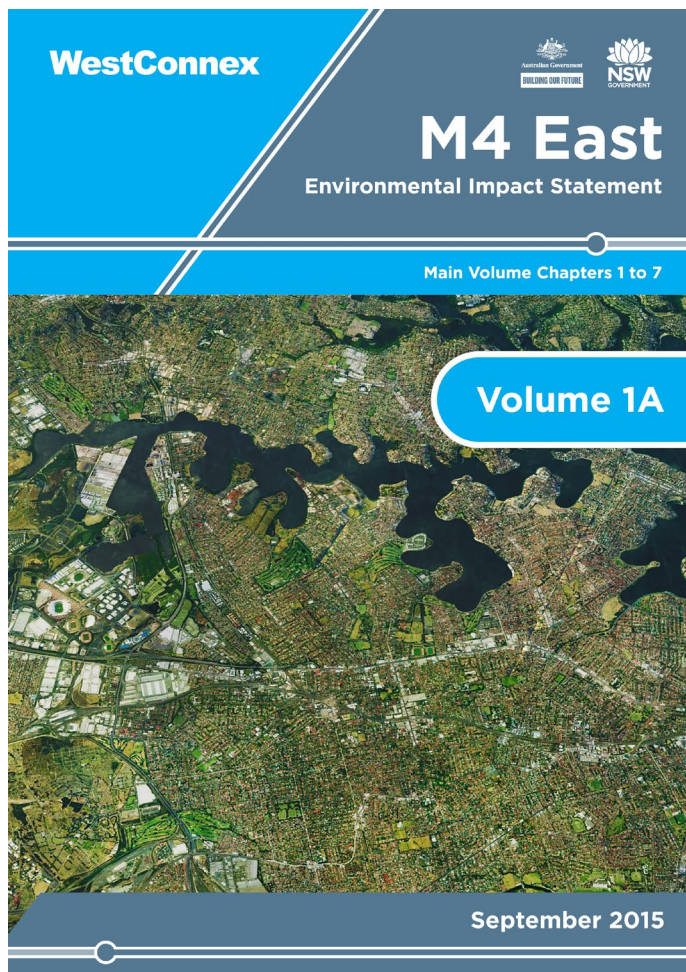


You are invited to make a submission on the M4 East Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), which is currently on exhibition.

WestConnex will consider all submissions received and provide a submissions report in response to the issues raised. The submissions report is submitted to the NSW Department of Planning and Environment and helps inform the Minister for Planning's decision on the project.

If the project is approved by the Minister for Planning, it will be constructed and operated in accordance with the mitigation measures described in the EIS, the submissions report and the conditions of approval.
