Cintra Park site establishment

Work is continuing to construct the WestConnex Motorway, linking Sydney's west and south-west with the city, airport and port. WestConnex will ease congestion, create jobs and connect communities.

Approval was recently given to construct M4 East and work will soon commence to establish Cintra Park as a tunnelling construction site. A layout of the site is provided overleaf.

To minimise impact on nearby residents, the majority of works will generally be undertaken **between 7am and 6pm from Monday to Friday and between 8am and 1pm on Saturday**. Some work may be done outside of these hours to ensure the safety of workers and motorists, and you will be notified if work is required near your property.

Work to establish the construction site will take about four months to complete, weather permitting, and will include:

- clearing vegetation and pruning trees
- removing and relocating utilities including electricity, communication, water and sewerage
- moving oversized equipment and machinery
- installing temporary fencing, gates, hoarding, noise walls and environmental controls including sedimentation ponds, a temporary water treatment plant and substation
- installing roads, footpaths, concrete foundations, piling, laydown areas, stockpile sites and temporary buildings, such as a site office, workshop, employee amenities, storage and acoustic shed
- excavating the temporary tunnel access point
- improving the existing car park adjacent to Concord Oval, along Gipps Street.

Equipment used throughout the work will include chainsaws, trucks, concrete cutters, generators, excavation and boring equipment, cranes, compressors, pumps, shotcrete rigs, mulchers and vibrating rollers.

Initially, construction vehicles will access Cintra Park from Gipps Street. Once the site is established, vehicles will access the site from Parramatta Road to minimise local road impacts.

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact of work, including by using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and, where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.

Traffic control will be in place if work is carried out near a road or pedestrian/cycle path. Pedestrians will be diverted to the south side of Parramatta Road between Luke Avenue and Cheltenham Road for the duration of the project to ensure their safety.

Early investigations indicate the site may contain contaminated material including asbestos. This is not unexpected given the historical industrial nature of land use in the area. If asbestos is found on the site, the following safety procedures will be implemented in line with WorkCover requirements, to ensure the safety of members of the community and workers:

- Air quality will be monitored.
- Signs, barriers and temporary fencing will surround areas containing asbestos.
- A hygienist will be on site to monitor and control the asbestos removal works.
- Any material containing asbestos will be encapsulated on site or loaded, transported and disposed of at licensed facilities by specially trained and licensed personnel.
