## Concord Road Interchange - site preparation night work update

Further to our notification on 21 July, 2016 night work to prepare for the establishment of the Concord Road construction site and realignment of the M4 Motorway will continue **from Tuesday, 2 August 2016**.

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists, this work will take place at night **between 9.00 pm and 5.00 am from Sunday to Friday**. A map of the work area and a schedule of dates is provided overleaf.

This work is expected to take around **five weeks to complete**, weather permitting and will include:


- installing concrete barriers adjacent to the M4 motorway eastbound carriageway to facilitate earthworks and removal of the noise wall during standard construction hours
- installing concrete barriers and hoarding on Sydney Street, North Strathfield
- geotechnical and service investigations on Sydney Street, North Strathfield and M4 motorway westbound carriageway including drilling bore holes
- identifying and relocating services and infrastructure including underground electricity and water, power poles, street lighting, and signage on Sydney Street, North Strathfield, Concord Road, and Parramatta Road, Concord
- vegetation removal
- setting up a safe work area with site specific environmental controls around each site
- excavating the road and footpath corridor
- restoring work sites to their previous condition
- reducing speed limits and temporarily closing lanes on the M4 Motorway, Concord Road, Sydney Street, and Queen Street.

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place during the work to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. If you travel along the work route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

Equipment used throughout the work will include cranes, elevated work platforms, insulated hydraulic chainsaws, wood chippers, excavators, vacuum trucks, drill rigs, and lighting towers.

There may be some noise associated with these works, however every effort will be made to minimise the impact of work, including by using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and, where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.
