Construction and traffic update – Underwood Road, Homebush

Further to our notification (N081) on 14 October 2016, work to finalise stage two of the temporary diversion of Underwood Road will continue.

From **Tuesday, 20 June 2017**, due to adverse weather conditions, some day time work is required to facilitate the slight realignment of Underwood Road in a westerly direction.

This work will take place **between 7.00 am and 6.00 pm, Monday to Friday**. A map of the work area is provided overleaf.

This work will take **up to three days to complete** and will include:

- lifting new traffic signals into place
- rewiring new traffic signals.

Once the work is complete, traffic travelling on Underwood Road will be realigned in a westerly direction onto a new section of road. This diversion will allow for the continued construction of the tunnel beneath Underwood Road and will be in place for **approximately four months**.

Equipment used throughout the work will include a franna crane and hand tools.

There will be some noise associated with this work, however every effort will be made to minimise the impact of work, including by completing road cutting activities on day shift where possible or before midnight, using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and, where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. Access to properties will be maintained at all times. Some parking restrictions may be in place during work hours.
