Traffic switch (Stage 3A) – M4 Motorway, Concord

Further to our previous notifications, work is continuing on the construction of the Concord Interchange.

On **Monday, 9 January 2017** work will commence on the M4 Motorway to shift a section of the eastbound carriageway onto the newly constructed pavement which was completed in Stage 2. This shift is required to allow for the construction of the M4 westbound bridge from Concord Road.

Due to high traffic volumes on the M4 Motorway, this work will be undertaken **from Sunday to Friday between 10.00 pm and 5.00 am** in order to reduce impacts on road users and ensure the safety of workers and motorists.

This work is expected to take up to **ten nights to complete**, weather permitting and will include:

- removing existing line marking
- installing concrete barriers
- removing the median
- installing new line marking and traffic signage on the M4 Motorway.

There will be some noise associated with this work, however every effort will be made to minimise the impact of work, including by using low-tonal reversing beepers on machinery during night work, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use, directing noisy equipment away from residences where possible, and undertaking regular noise monitoring to ensure noise levels are within the approved threshold.

Equipment used will include excavators, bobcats, rock breakers, road/concrete saws, jackhammers, asphalt pavers, compactors, vacuum excavation trucks, cranes, light vehicles and trucks, concrete trucks, semi-trailers, lighting towers, and hand tools.

During the work, the M4 motorway eastbound carriageway will be closed between Sydney Street and Parramatta Road, Concord. A map showing the traffic detour and work area is provided overleaf.

Traffic control, detour signage and pedestrian management will be in place during the work to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. If you travel along the work route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and the direction of traffic controllers.
