Westbound on-ramp closure – M4 Motorway Concord

Following recent works undertaken on the M4 motorway between Sydney Street and Parramatta Road, North Strathfield the M4 westbound on-ramp from Concord Road will be permanently closed. This closure is a necessary part of the M4 East project, as it facilitates the construction of the new M4 westbound bridge from Concord Road. See map overleaf for work area.

From 10.00 pm Friday, 17 March 2017, the M4 motorway westbound on-ramp from Concord Road, near the intersection of Parramatta Road and Leicester Street will be permanently closed. Motorists will still be able to access the M4 motorway westbound at Homebush Bay Drive and Silverwater Road Junctions.

Work to close the ramp will be undertaken **between 10.00 pm and 5.00 am** in order to reduce impacts on road users and ensure the safety of workers and motorists.

This work is expected to take up to **four nights** to complete, weather permitting and will include:

- removing existing line marking
- installation of concrete barriers
- installing new traffic signage
- closure of M4 motorway westbound on-ramp from Concord Road
- footpath closure on western side of Concord Road in vicinity of ramp

There will be some noise associated with this work, however every effort will be made to minimise the impact of work, including by using low-tonal reversing beepers on machinery during night works, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use, directing noisy equipment away from residences where possible, and undertaking regular noise monitoring to ensure levels are being managed effectively.

Equipment used will include excavators, bobcats, rock breakers, road/concrete saws, jackhammers, asphalt pavers, compactors, vacuum excavation trucks, cranes, light vehicles and trucks, concrete trucks, semi-trailers, lighting towers, and hand tools.

During the work, the M4 motorway east and westbound carriageways will be closed between Parramatta Road, Concord and Homebush Bay Drive, Homebush. A single lane closure, northbound on Concord Road, North Strathfield is also required.

Traffic control, signage and pedestrian management will be in place during the work to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. If you travel along the work route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and the direction of traffic controllers.

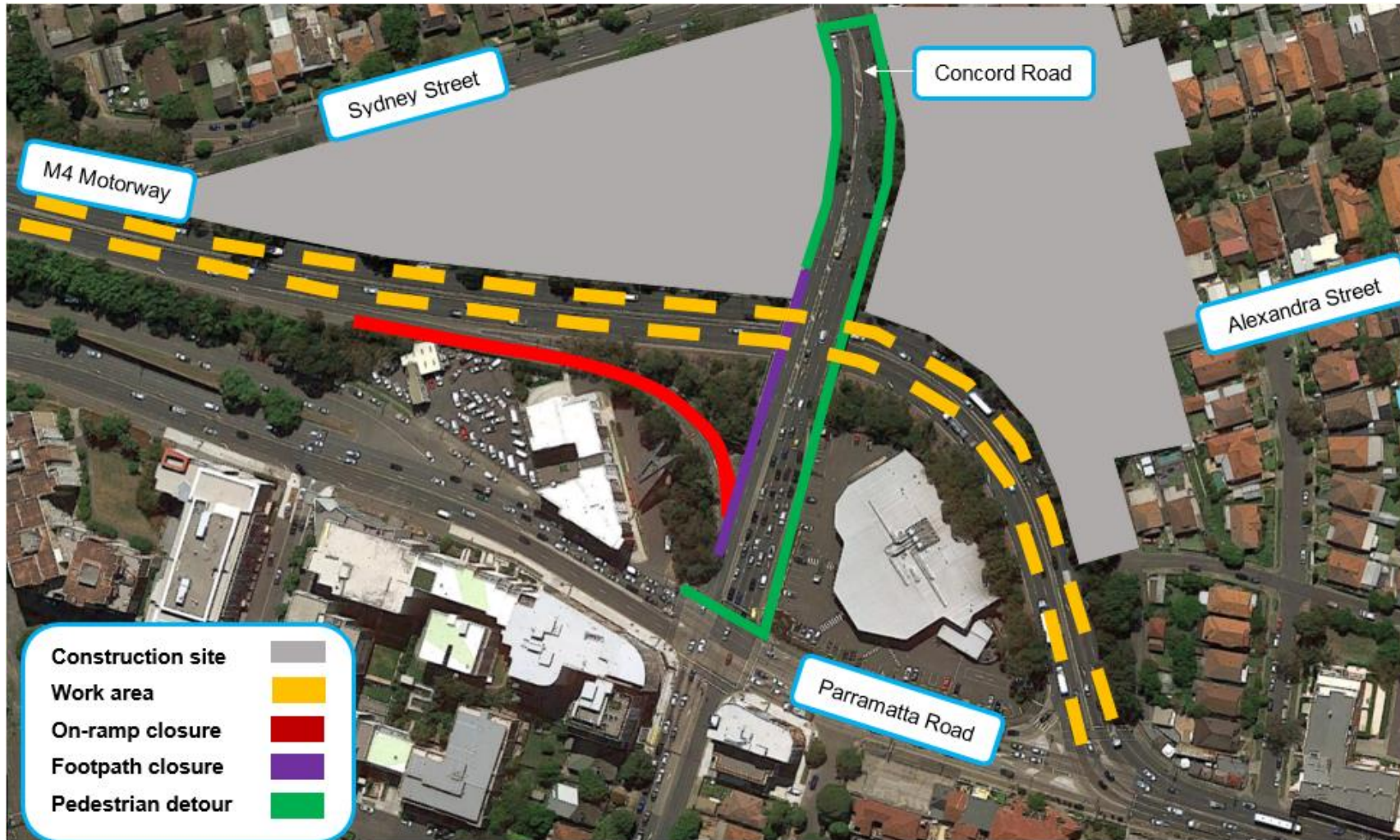
