



Sewer diversion - Carrington Lane and Queen Lane, North Strathfield

Further to notification N213e and following community agreement, the sewer bypass pumps at the corner of Carrington and Queen Lanes will be operational from Thursday, 26 April 2018. The sewer bypass pumps will be required to operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, for up to 7 weeks.

A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

What we're doing

The work will involve:

- pumping the sewer through bypass set up on Queen Lane
- refuelling of sewer bypass pumps during day shift.

No major equipment is required for the running of the sewer bypass pump system.

How this affects you

There will be some noise associated with this work and monitoring will be undertaken to measure and validate the noise generated by the pump system.
