## Concord on-ramp bridge girder installation – M4 Motorway, Concord

Further to notification N225, from **Monday, 20 November 2017** work will continue to install the substructures, called girders, to support the new Concord Road on-ramp bridge connecting Concord Road southbound to the M4 Motorway westbound. Six of the twelve steel girders have already been lifted into position and the remaining six will be installed in the coming weeks. During this work, night time closures of the M4 Motorway will be required.

### Timing and work hours

Work to install the remaining girders will be completed in **lots of two consecutive nights per week (four evenings in total)**. Work requiring road or lane closures will occur between **9.30 pm and 5.00 am Sunday to Friday**.

We will re-notify you if we are unable to complete the work during this period or if there are any major changes.

### Work activities include:

- delivery of the oversized girders to site via a jinker trailer under escort
- lifting of the girder into position using a 500 tonne mobile crane
- tree trimming along the girder alignment to allow for the installation.

Equipment used will include a 500 tonne crane, powered access equipment, excavators, trucks, traffic control equipment, semi-trailers, lighting towers, and hand tools.

### Minimising impact

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this including using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and, where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.

### Traffic changes

During this work, **night time closures of the M4 Motorway will be required**. Road closures will vary depending on the position of the girder. Specific information regarding these closures will be communicated via comprehensive Variable Message Signage, local advertising and [livetraffic.com](http://livetraffic.com).

Traffic control, signage and pedestrian management will be in place during the work to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. If you travel along the work route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and the direction of traffic controllers.
