



## Ongoing construction work - Haberfield

From Wednesday, 4 April 2018, work will continue along Wattle Street and Dobroyd Parade, Haberfield. A map showing the location of work, as well as road closures is provided overleaf.

This work includes the continued temporary closure of Ash Lane at the intersection of Wattle Street, Haberfield which is expected to reopen in May.

### What we're doing

This work will involve:

- road and pavement work including the installation of traffic barriers, signage, line marking and asphalt, and the remediation of footpaths and driveways;
- utility investigation, trenching, potholing and installation (including street lighting and drainage);
- spoil delivery and stockpiling activities.

Equipment used during the work will include excavators, vacuum trucks, concrete saws, cranes, trucks, compactors, road line markers, graders, asphalt laying plant, trucks, small tools, hand tools and lighting equipment.

### How this affects you

There will be some noise associated with this work, however every effort will be made to minimise this by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.

Traffic control will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. Parking will be restricted in the vicinity of the work. Pedestrian can access Ramsay Street between Walker Avenue and Wattle Street via the western side of Ramsay Street only.
