



Overhead electrical work - Parramatta Road, Ashfield

From Sunday, 15 April 2018 work will commence to relocate existing overhead electrical cables underground. A map showing the location of the preparatory work is provided overleaf.

This work is in preparation for the installation of a new Variable Message Sign (VMS), which is scheduled to occur in mid-2018. The future sign will provide road users with up-to-date information on traffic conditions, planned and unplanned incidents, and events.

If the work cannot be completed during this period, it will be rescheduled and you will be notified.

What we're doing

This remaining work will involve:

- installing electrical cables below ground.

Equipment used during the work will include vacuum trucks, cranes, small trucks, compactors, electronic lifting platforms, small tools, hand tools and lighting equipment.

How this affects you

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this by using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery at night, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.

In an effort to minimise additional impacts experienced as a result of unexpected construction delays, we provide residents with weekly email updates about upcoming out-of-hours work in the area.
