



Preparation work for the variable message sign - Dobroyd Parade and Crane Avenue, Haberfield

On Wednesday, 11 July 2018 work will continue on the recently installed permanent variable message sign (VMS) on Dobroyd Parade, Haberfield. The sign will provide road users with up-to-date information on traffic conditions and planned and unplanned incidents and events. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

This preparation work is expected to take a further month to complete and you will be notified when further work to commission the sign is required.

What we're doing

The remaining work will involve:

- connecting power and telecommunications cabling to an existing point of supply on Crane Avenue via an in-ground trench;
- permanently restoring the footpath and affected driveway.

Equipment used during the work will include vacuum trucks, trucks, concrete agitators, concrete saws and hand tools.

The approved Traffic and Access Management Plan (TAMP) for this work allows vehicles to access Crane Avenue via Waratah Street and Chelmsford Avenue from Dobroyd Parade (City-West Link).

How this affects you

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. Parking may be restricted in the vicinity of the work to ensure this work can be completed on day shift.

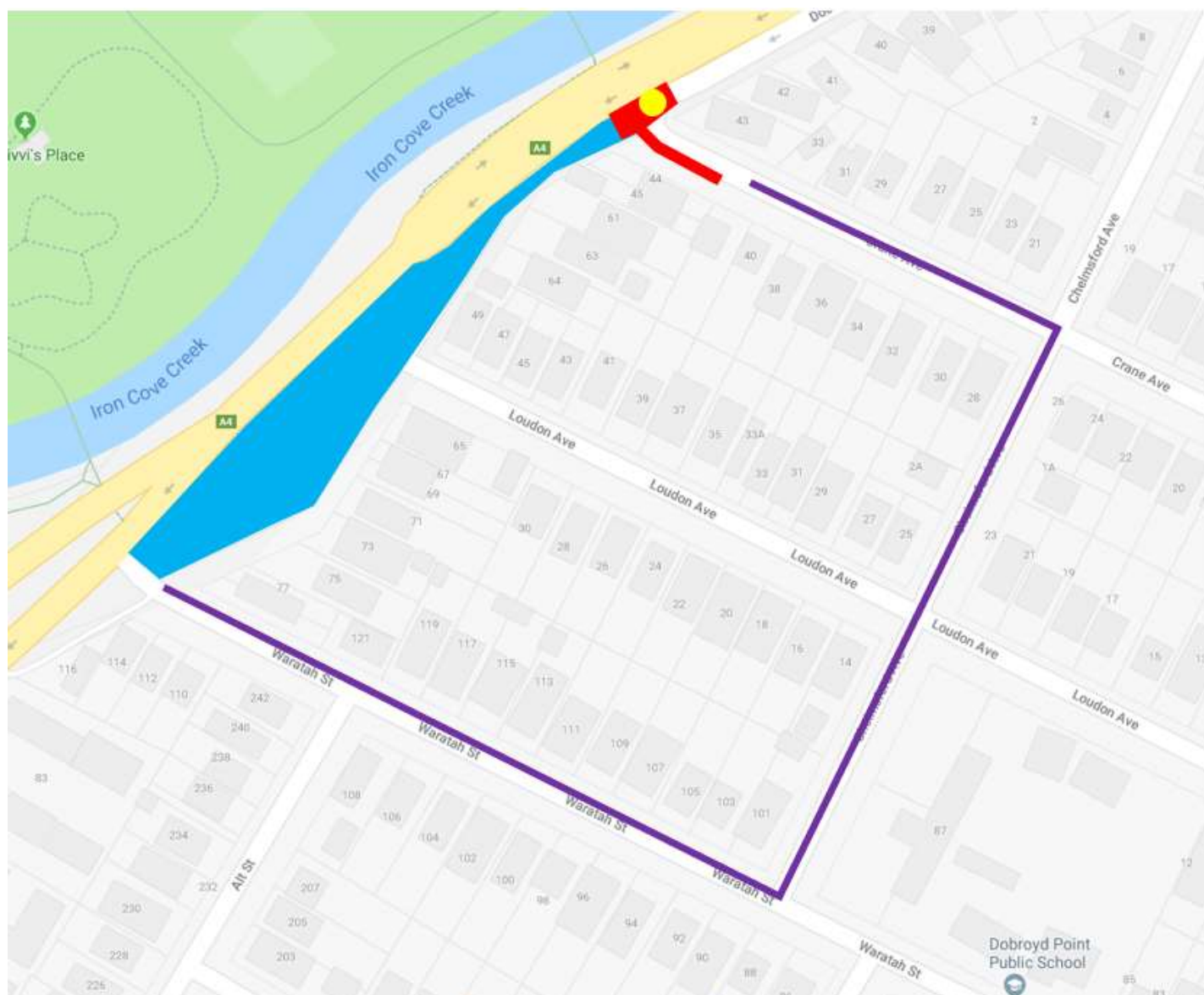
