



Preparation for signage installation - Parramatta Road, Ashfield

From Monday, 19 March 2018, work to prepare for the future installation of permanent traffic signage will commence. The signs will provide road users with directional information. This work is expected to take one month to complete. For safety purposes, it will be carried out at night when traffic volumes are lower. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

What we're doing

This work will involve:

- installing temporary barriers to delineate the work zone from Ashfield Park
- investigating, modifying and installing utility services
- excavating and pouring concrete for sign foundations
- placing a steel plate over the work area prior to installation of the sign
- rebuilding the footpath.

Equipment used during the work will include vacuum trucks, concrete saws (before midnight only), trucks, a franna crane, concrete agitators, concrete vibrators, an excavator, a truck mounted piling rig, a kerbing machine, a generator and lighting towers.

How this affects you

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this by using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery at night, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians, residents and workers. Parking may be restricted in the vicinity of the work. If you travel along the route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers.

In an effort to minimise additional impacts experienced as a result of unexpected construction delays, we provide residents with weekly email updates about out-of-hours work in the area. 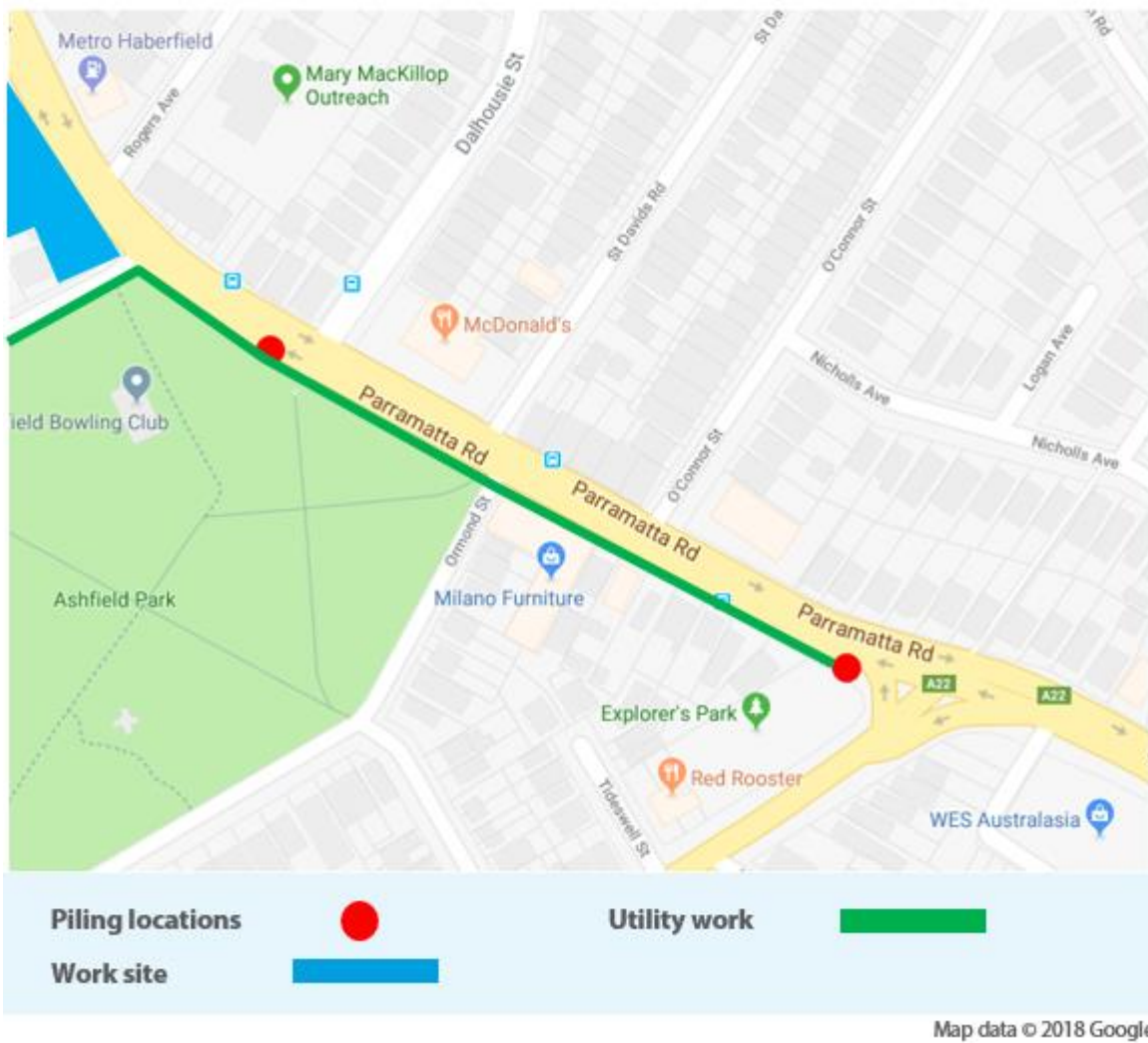
