



## Temporary road closures - Ramsay Street, Haberfield

In addition to the closure of Ramsay Street from Thursday 23 to Monday 26 March 2018 (approved), the same intersection will again be closed from Thursday 29 March to Tuesday 2 April 2018 (Easter long weekend). This second closure, pending approval, is to complete the installation of stormwater drainage for the future Wattle Street Interchange, Ramsay Street. There will be no through access from Ramsay Street across the intersection during this time.

A map showing the location of work, bus and traffic detours is provided overleaf. Additional closures are anticipated and residents will be notified.

### What we're doing

This work will involve:

- removing temporary traffic signage, line marking and barriers;
- excavating the drainage trench and removing existing, redundant utility services;
- installing new stormwater drainage pipes and pits;
- backfilling and restoring the road surface.

Equipment used during the work will include franna cranes, asphalt trucks, plate compactor, roller, paver, vacuum trucks, hammers, concrete saws, excavators, lighting towers, generators, trucks, concrete agitators, line marking trucks and hand tools.

### How this affects you

Drivers travelling north on Ramsay Street will be detoured via Dalhousie Street, Parramatta Road, Great North Road. Drivers travelling south on Ramsay Street will be detoured via Wattle Street, Waratah Street and Alt Street. Drivers can still turn left from Ramsay Street into Wattle Street and left from Wattle Street onto Ramsay Street.

Bus detours will be in place for routes 438, 439, L38 and L39. A map showing the bus diversions and the road closure is provided overleaf. Pedestrian access will be maintained on the western side of the Ramsay Street intersection.

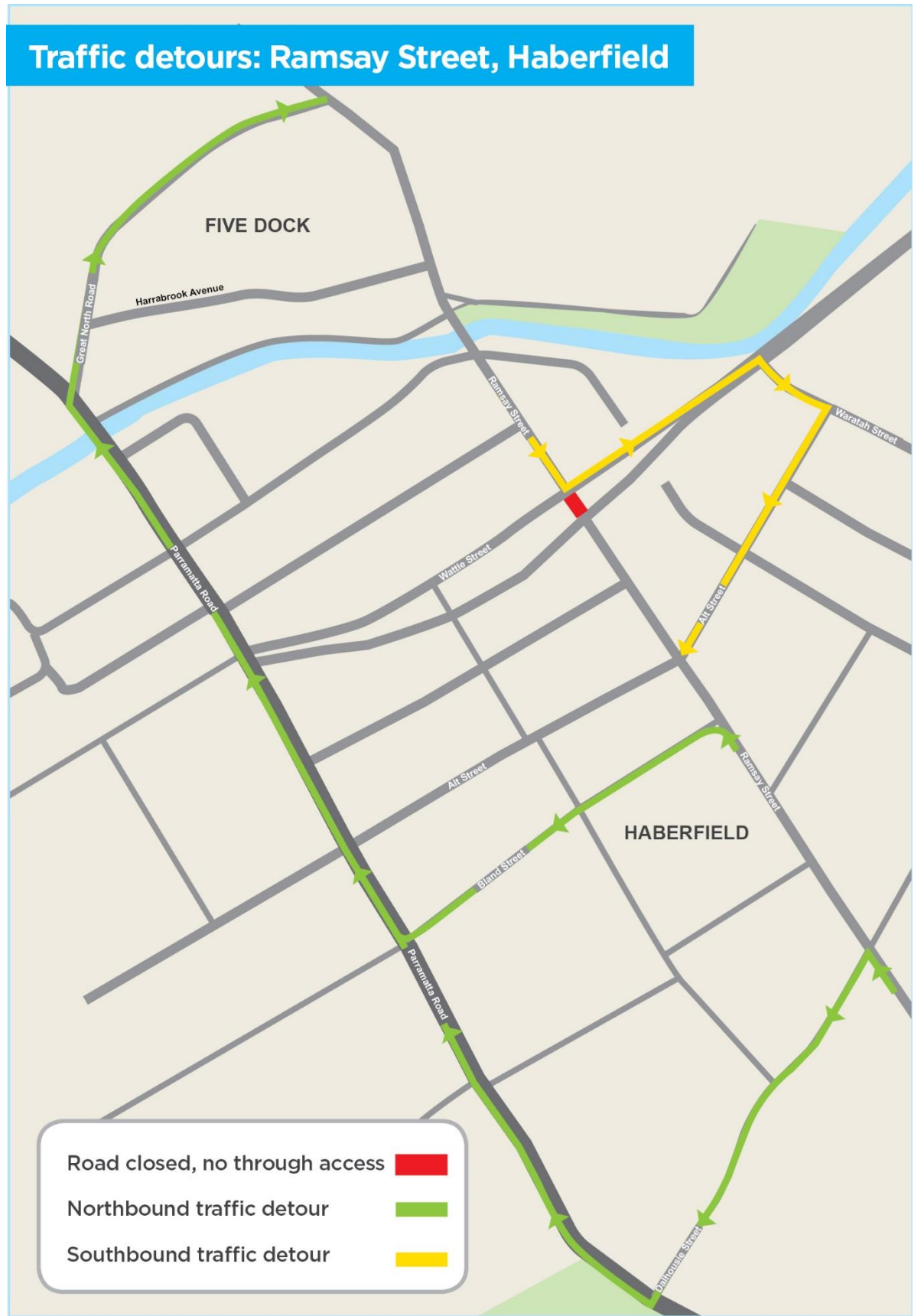
