



Intelligent Transport System installation - M4 Motorway, Homebush

From Thursday, 22 March 2018, work will continue to install Intelligent Transport System (ITS) infrastructure and Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) on the M4 Motorway and Homebush Bay Drive, Homebush. This work will require closures on the M4 Motorway and the M4 Motorway on-ramp at Homebush Bay Drive. This work is expected to take up to three months to complete, weather permitting. Residents will be notified as work progresses.

Testing of the toll gantry will commence shortly after installation. Toll tags may beep when driving under the gantry, however, no tolls will be charged. A notification will be distributed to the community before toll collection starts.

A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

What we're doing

This work will involve:

- utilities investigation and installation (including cable pulling)
- installation of ITS gantries and cabinets
- traffic signal modifications
- signage installation
- asphaltting work
- installing medians
- ITS installation
- installation of CCTV posts with cameras.

Equipment used during the work will include excavators, piling rig, vacuum trucks, concrete saws, core drills, chainsaws, cranes, elevated work platform, trucks, compactors, site vehicles, small tools, hand tools and lighting equipment.

How this affects you

During this work, full closures of the M4 Motorway westbound and eastbound, and lane closures on Homebush Bay Drive, will be required. Specific information regarding these closures will be communicated via comprehensive Variable Message Sign (VMS) and livetraffic.com. Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. If you travel along the route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers.

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this by using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery at night, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences. All sites will also be restored to their previous condition.
