



Line marking - Ramsay Street and Martin Street, Haberfield

Following community feedback, the M4 East Project have gained approval to paint a 'Do Not Queue Across the Intersection' sign on the road at the intersection of Martin Street and Ramsay Street, Haberfield.

This work will take up to two shifts to complete, weather conditions permitting. Due to its proximity to the road, work will be carried out at night when the traffic volumes are lower.

A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

What we're doing

This work will involve:

- Line marking and sealing the road.

Equipment used during the work will include hand tools, a line marking truck and lighting towers.

How this affects you

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this by using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery at night, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians, residents and workers. Parking may be restricted in the vicinity of the work. If you travel along the route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers.

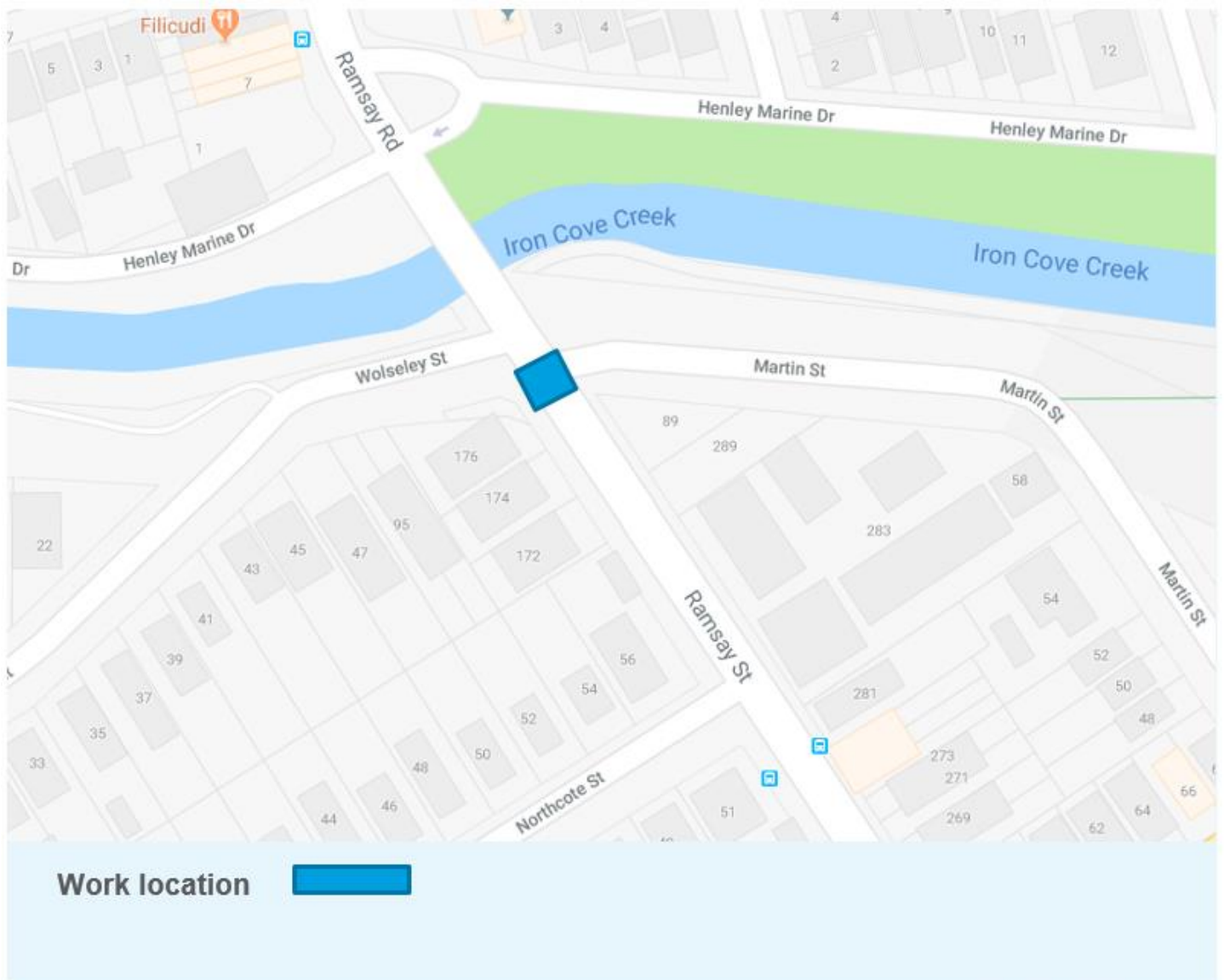
