



Changed traffic conditions - Parramatta Road Civil Site

To facilitate the re-alignment of Parramatta Road eastbound between Bland Street and Dalhousie Street, Chandos Street at the intersection of Parramatta Road will be temporarily closed.

The closure will be in place from 9:00pm Saturday 16 June 2018. This work will take up to six months to complete, with updates provided to the community monthly. A map showing the location of the work, traffic changes and bus stops is provided overleaf.

Pedestrian access along Parramatta Road and Chandos Street will be maintained as well as access to businesses along Parramatta Road.

What we're doing

This work will involve:

- installing traffic barriers
- identifying, relocating, and installing utilities (including drainage)
- temporary line marking and placement of directional markers
- pavement work including construction of new kerb and gutters
- installing temporary directional signage.

Equipment used will include vacuum trucks, line marking equipment, cranes, millers, pavers, drum rollers, excavators, compactor plates, trucks, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, hand tools and lighting equipment.

How this affects you

During this closure, Chandos Street at the intersection of Parramatta Road will be closed. Motorists can access Chandos Street via Bland Street or Dalhousie Street and Denman Avenue to access Chandos Street.

The bus stop at Chandos Street will be permanently closed. Customers can use the Bland Street stop as an alternative. The bus stop at Dalhousie Street will be temporarily closed. Customers can use the Saint Davids Road bus stop as an alternative.
