



Construction and Utility Work - Parramatta Road Civil Site

From Sunday, 9 September 2018, work continues around the Parramatta Road Construction Site. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf. This work is expected to take up to two months to complete with updates provided to the community monthly.

During this time, weekend work on Chandos Street, Haberfield may be required. You will be notified separately when this work is scheduled.

What we're doing

This work will involve:

- road work including adjusting traffic barriers (including adjusting them in front of businesses, whilst still maintaining access), asphaltting, signage, crash cushions and line marking;
- investigating, installing and modifying utility and other services;
- finalising panel installation on the Bland Street pedestrian bridge;
- reconfiguring and installing traffic signals at Bland Street, Ashfield.

Equipment used will include vacuum trucks, asphalt corers, line marking equipment, cranes, drum rollers, excavators, compactor plates, trucks, concrete saws, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, hand tools and lighting equipment.

How this affects you

During this work, Chandos Street at the intersection of Parramatta Road will continue to be closed. Motorists can access Chandos Street via Bland Street or Dalhousie Street and Denman Avenue to access Chandos Street.

The bus stop at Chandos Street will be permanently closed. Customers can use the Bland Street stop as an alternative. The bus stop at Dalhousie Street will be temporarily closed. Customers can use the Saint David's Road bus stop as an alternative.

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. If you travel along the route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers.

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this including turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use, applying respite periods and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.


