



Changed traffic conditions - Wattle Street, Haberfield

Due to scheduling issues, the upcoming traffic changes outlined in Notification (N361) will now occur over two weekends. From Saturday, 11 August 2018 work will commence to implement significant traffic changes along Wattle Street, Haberfield (between Parramatta Road and Crane Avenue), weather and ground conditions permitting. These major traffic changes are outlined below and shown on the maps provided overleaf:

- Changes to be made on night 1 - Saturday, 11 August (shown in orange):
 - splitting traffic heading westbound on Wattle Street towards Parramatta Road, vehicles turning left onto Parramatta Road need to remain in the far left lane.
- Changes to be made on night 2 - Saturday, 18 August (shown in pink):
 - opening new right turn lane from Wattle Street eastbound to Ramsay Street southbound (towards Haberfield);
 - closure of the right turn (G-Loop) from Wattle Street onto Waratah Street;
 - implementing a temporary no right turn from Waratah Street onto Dobroyd Parade (City West Link) which will be in place for this package of work;
 - opening an additional right turn lane from Wattle Street westbound to Ramsay Street northbound (towards Five Dock).

What we're doing

This work will involve:

- installing and relocating traffic barriers, temporary signage and crash cushions;
- asphalt and pavement work;
- temporary line marking and placement of directional markers;
- reconfiguring of traffic signals.

Equipment used will include vacuum trucks, concrete saws, line marking equipment, cranes, millers, pavers, drum rollers, excavators, compactor plates, trucks, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, hand tools and lighting equipment.

How this affects you

For motorists travelling citybound on Wattle Street there will be no right turn (G-Loop) from Wattle Street into Waratah Street. Motorists can use the new right turn from Wattle Street onto Ramsay Street to access Waratah Street, Haberfield. There is also a temporary traffic change of no right turn from Waratah Street onto Dobroyd Parade (City West Link) which will be in place for this package of work.

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. If you travel along the route, please allow for extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers.
