



Legacy works – Arnott's Reserve and Allen Street Reserve, Homebush

From Monday, 24 September 2018, work will commence to enhance Arnott's Reserve and Allen Street Reserve in Homebush. The initial phase of this work will be on-site investigation and remediation works in Arnott's Reserve which will assist in the final design of the reserve.

The work is expected to take seven months to complete, weather permitting. You will be notified as work progresses.

A map showing the location of this initial phase of the work is provided overleaf.

What we're doing

The work will involve:

- Geotechnical investigation
- Site remediation work
- Vegetation clearing
- Installation and removal of Fencing

Equipment used during the work will include: sucker truck, drill rig/ute rig, spoil truck, flatbed truck, concrete truck, Manitou, franna, chainsaw, mulcher, excavator, generator, hand tools, light vehicles and trailers.

How this affects you

There will be some noise associated with this work. Every effort will be made to minimise this impact including by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noisy equipment away from residences where possible.
