Notification of survey, geotechnical and services/utilities investigations for the M4 East

The NSW and Australian governments have embarked on Australia's largest transport infrastructure project, the WestConnex Motorway linking Sydney's west and south-west with the city, airport and port. WestConnex will ease congestion, create jobs and connect communities.

Leighton Samsung John Holland (LSJH) has been selected to deliver the extension of the M4 between Homebush and Haberfield.

Planning for the M4 East is underway. As part of this work, contractors will conduct survey, geotechnical and utility investigations at various locations throughout the project study area. These areas will include Parramatta Road, the M4 Western Motorway, Concord Road, Wattle Street and other nearby local streets.

Work will take place at various temporary sites between August 2015 and the end of February 2016, weather permitting. The majority of work will be completed during the day between 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm Saturday however some night survey work may be required.

Most of this work will take place in public areas, such as roads, however access to private property may be required. This access will be negotiated with individual property owners in advance. Access to private properties will be maintained

These investigations are an important part of supporting and confirming the planning and design work currently underway for the project. The information will be used to inform geographical, geotechnical and utility profiles of the area.

Survey

Survey is used to define property boundaries, building locations and heights above sea level. This work will involve teams using surveying equipment to collect data and will take less than a day to complete at any one location. The activities will include traditional survey techniques as well as mobile laser scanning using a scanner mounted on the back of a utility vehicle scanning the road. A support traffic vehicle may also be used in some locations to slow traffic in order to obtain precise readings.

Geotechnical investigations

Geotechnical investigations will take place at approximately 70 sites along the project corridor. A temporary worksite with safety fencing will be set up at the location to securely contain the drilling equipment. Traffic control arrangements will be put in place if the work is taking place near a road or pedestrian/cycle path. At the completion of the test work, all sites will be restored to their original condition.

The sites have been selected to minimise inconvenience to road users and pedestrians where possible, and will only be operational during the day. This work will take between two and four days and will generate intermittent noise for short periods.

Utility investigations

Investigations to confirm the location of utilities and services will be carried out around the planned tunnel entry/exit points and interchange areas. This work will involve potholing to check for services and will generate intermittent noise for short periods. All sites will be returned to their prior condition once the work has been completed.

All feasible and reasonable mitigation measures will be taken to minimise disturbance to local residents and businesses during this time. We apologise for any disruption that may be experienced and aim to have the works completed as quickly as possible.
