



Preparation work for the variable message sign - Dobroyd Parade, Haberfield

On Monday, 9 April 2018 preparation work will continue for the installation of a permanent variable message sign (VMS) on Dobroyd Parade, Haberfield. The sign will provide road users with up-to-date information on traffic conditions and planned and unplanned incidents and events. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

This work is expected to take a further two months to complete and residents will be updated monthly.

What we're doing

The remaining work will involve:

- excavating, piling and pouring foundations
- installing power and telecommunications cabling.

Equipment used during the work will include vacuum trucks, lighting equipment, trucks, concrete agitators, a truck mounted piling rig and small hand tools.

The approved Traffic and Access Management Plan (TAMP) for this work allows vehicles to access Crane Avenue via Waratah Street and Chelmsford Avenue from Dobroyd Parade (City-West Link).

How this affects you

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this by using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery at night, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.
